Introducing The Beach House, a newly renovated bungalow situated in the quiet and prestigious Amagansett Dunes neighborhood.

Located a short distance from the Amagansett Main Street, this beach cottage is owned and curated by the owner of The Roundtree, Amagansett. The local ocean beach, which stretches for miles on end, is a short walk away and accessible by private pathways.

Built in the 1960s by renowned East Hampton architect Alfred Scheffer, this retreat was originally owned by the famous Tony Award-winning playwright Neil Simon, best known for the "Odd Couple." In fact, Simon received the first of his many Tonys while he called the property home.
